Service Guide i850 / i851

This service guide is suitable for KS i850 lever and KS i851 remote lever seatposts.

It is intended to show how to disassemble and service your post. Anything not shown in this guide is not user serviceable and should not be attempted. Please contact your shop or distributor for more information.

First remove from bicycle and clean off any external dirt to prevent contamination of internals. Using a 13mm socket undo the nut on the bottom of the seatpost.

Undo the upper collar and lift up seal with the collar

Slide lowers off the stanchion.

You should have the following parts disassembled: upper assembly, lowers, nut, collar and seal.

Clean off all old grease, and clean. Regrease with suitable waterproof grease, and reassemble.

Do not attempt to dismantle the upper assembly further. Compressed gas may cause explosion.

Please note that if the post is regularly run in poor conditions the grease will be contaminated and will need replacing with this simple service guide.

The white bush is a wear and tear part, it is available as a spare part if it needs replacing to remove play. A lack of servicing will increase the rate of wear on this part.
